Subject: Invitation to Submit your application for the MSF Luxembourg Board

Dear MSF Luxembourg Members,

This year, the MSF Luxembourg Board has two vacant positions, open to medical, paramedical, or non-medical profiles. Board members represent the voices of the association's members for a three-year term.

We are seeking motivated, committed, and dedicated individuals who are ready to get involved in the Board.

The Board is responsible for ensuring the implementation of MSF's social mission and the proper use of its funds. Its main duties include guiding, supporting, and constructively challenging the executive team in its strategic decisions, fostering associative democracy, and playing a key representative role within the international movement.

Board members are at the heart of decisions that shape our association, not only in Luxembourg but also in the entire movement. They provide guidance to the General Director, validate strategic priorities and budgets, and contribute to the MSF's evolution.

This year, the Board has worked on the self-declaration, held discussions on OD partnerships, prepared the celebration of the 40 years of MSF Luxembourg taking place in March 2026, and worked on coordination between LuxOR and the Foundation. Additionally, some Board members sit on the Board of the MSF Foundation for Humanitarian Research and oversee governance and budget-related matters.

To continue addressing these challenges with the necessary commitment and diversity of perspectives, the Board warmly invites you to submit your candidacy [via this form](#) by **April 15, 2026**¹.

Once submitted, your application will be reviewed by the election committee during week 17 (from April 20 to 24), and you will receive a response regarding its validity. If accepted, you will officially become a candidate and have the opportunity to present yourself to the General Assembly on Saturday, May 9, 2026, and answer questions from association members.

Please note that if you are not yet an MSF Luxembourg member, you will need to go through the membership application process. Also, if elected, please be aware that you will be required to provide an extensive list of documents in order to comply with local regulations. This list will be shared with you if your application is deemed eligible.
